## Consider being a Board of Directors Member things to know

The Board is made up of 7 members of our Association, following are the board positions:

- Chairman
- Vice-Chairman
- Secretary
- Treasurer
- 3 At-Large Members

Five (5) Board members have reached term limit. We will be holding an election for these vacancies at the upcoming Annual HOA meeting. Nominations for filling these slots will come from the Nominating Committee, the Board and from the floor during the meeting. The newly constituted Board will then select the individual Board positions (ie Chairman, Treasurer, Secretary etc.). In other words, you will be nominating and electing Board members and not specific positions.

Requirements and Qualifications: for more information See Amended By-Laws Article 4-6

- Terms are 2 years.
- Member must be willing to attend Board meetings.
- Member must be willing to complete the tasks as described in Article 6. Board of Directors in the Amended By-Laws.
- Member must be available to serve on Committees when needed.
- Member must be available to assist other Board members with tasks when needed.
- Member is expected to assist the Board with the enforcement of the Association's Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions (CC\&Rs) and the Amended ByLaws.

If you feel you meet all of the above criteria and would accept a nomination to be elected to the Board, please be prepared to introduce yourself and give a brief explanation as to why you feel you would be an asset to the Board and our community. Remember to either have someone nominate you at the meeting or submit your name to the Board for nomination. It will also require a second (from either the Board or HOA membership) to include your name on the roster of candidates to be selected.

Reminder: If you choose to have a proxy for your vote or have a proxy to vote for someone, the proxy form must be received by mail or hand delivered to a member of the board member by February 8, 2023. Proxies cannot be used for voting if brought to the HOA meeting.
